

## Dr Richard A. Debs

### Chairman of the Board of Directors

- Mr. Richard A. Debs is an Advisory Director of Morgan Stanley, having retired as the founding President of Morgan Stanley International. He now serves as Chairman of Morgan Stanley Saudi Arabia.
  - Previously Mr. Debs had served as the Chief Operating Officer of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, and as an alternate member of the Federal Open Market Committee. He is the U.S. Chairman of the Bretton Woods International Counsel, past Chairman of the New York Stock Exchange International Committee, a member of the Group of Thirty, and has served from time to time as an advisor to the World Bank, the International Monetary Fund, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, and the Federal Reserve. He is Vice Chairman, Chairman Emeritus and a founding member of the U.S. Saudi Arabian Business Council.
  - Mr. Debs is a founding member of the Committee on Islamic Law of the Association of the Bar of the City of New York, and among his publications is the treatise "Islamic Law in Egypt". He is Chairman Emeritus of the American University of Beirut and is Chairman of its International Advisory Council. He is also Chairman Emeritus of Carnegie Hall, and has served as a director of the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, the Institute of International Education, the Federation of Protestant Welfare Agencies, and several business and financial corporations.
  - Mr. Debs was a Fulbright Scholar in Egypt and a Ford Foundation Fellow, and holds a Ph.D. from Princeton and is a graduate of the Harvard Law School and the AMP program of the Harvard Business School.
