The Fund seeks long-term capital appreciation by investing primarily in high quality companies located or operating in developing or emerging market countries, with capitalizations within the range of companies in the MSCI Emerging Markets Net Index. To achieve its objective, the investment team seeks companies they believe are undervalued at the time of purchase and have sustainable competitive advantages and long-term growth that creates value, rather than focusing on short-term events. Stock selection is informed by rigorous fundamental analysis.







DEFINITIONS

5 year free cash flow growth is the compound annual growth rate of Free Cash Flow over a 5-year period. It is calculated by $[\text{Free Cash Flow}(0) / \text{Free Cash Flow}(-5)]^{1/5} - 1$. **5 year sales growth** is the compound annual growth rate of Sales over the last 5 years. It is calculated by $[\text{Sales}(0) / \text{Sales}(-5)]^{1/5} - 1$. **Active Share** is a measure of the percentage of stock holdings in a managers portfolio that differ from the benchmark index (based on holdings and weight of holdings). Active Share scores range from 0%-100%. A score of 100% means you are completely different from the benchmark. Active Share calculation may consolidate holdings with the same economic exposure. **Bloomberg** stands for 'Bloomberg Global Identifier (BBGID)'. This is a unique 12 digit alphanumeric code designed to enable the identification of securities, such as the Morgan Stanley Investment Funds sub-funds at share class level, on a Bloomberg Terminal. The Bloomberg Terminal, a system provided by Bloomberg L.P., enables analysts to access and analyse real-time financial market data. Each Bloomberg code starts with the same BBG prefix, followed by nine further characters that we list here in this guide for each share class of each fund. **ISIN** is the international securities identification number (ISIN), a 12 digit code consisting of numbers and letters that distinctly identifies securities. **NAV** is the Net Asset Value per share of the Fund (NAV), which represents the value of the assets of a fund less its liabilities. **Net cash to equity** is the ratio of a company's cash on hand against the total net worth of the company. It is calculated by $[(\text{Total Cash and cash equivalents} - \text{Total$

The portfolio may exceed this from time to time due to market conditions and outstanding trades. **Return on assets (ROA)** is a measure of a company's profitability, equal to a fiscal year's earnings divided by its total assets, expressed as a percentage. **Return on invested capital (ROIC)** represents the performance ratio measuring a company's percentage return on its invested capital. Income statement items as of latest reported fiscal period, and Balance Sheet items from one period earlier. ROIC is calculated by dividing Net Income by (Property, Plant & Equipment + Working Capital + Short Term Debt - Cash & Equivalents). ROIC has a cap of 200% and a floor of 0%, ex Financials and Real Estate Sectors. **Weighted average market capitalization** is an average of the market capitalization of stocks comprising a portfolio or index, adjusted by each stock's weight in the portfolio or index.

INDEX INFORMATION

The **MSCI Emerging Markets Net Index** is a free float-adjusted market capitalization weighted index that is designed to measure equity market performance of emerging markets. The term "free float" represents the portion of shares outstanding that are deemed to be available for purchase in the public equity markets by investors. The **MSCI Emerging Markets Index** currently consists of 23 emerging-market country indices. The performance of the index is listed in U.S. dollars and assumes reinvestment of net dividends.

The index has been chosen for performance comparison purposes because

it is a broad global equity index that represents large and medium sized company performance across developed countries.
