GLOBAL OPPORTUNITY

Investors should note that, relative to the expectations of the Autorité des Marchés Financiers, this UCITS presents disproportionate communication on the consideration of extra-financial criteria in its management.

Performance Review

In the one month period ending 31 December 2024, the Fund's Z shares returned -2.32% (net of fees)¹, while the benchmark returned -2.37%.

In the quarter ended 31 December 2024, the Fund's Z shares returned 4.43% and the benchmark returned -0.99%.

Year-to-date, the Fund's Z shares returned 27.28% and the benchmark returned 17.49%.

The Global Opportunity team creates a high conviction, concentrated portfolio of undervalued, high quality businesses. The long-term investment horizon and high active share approach can result in periods of performance deviation from the benchmark. The Fund outperformed the MSCI All Country ("AC") World Index this quarter due to favourable stock selection and sector allocation.

Market Review

Global equities declined during the quarter, led lower by underperformance in the materials, health care and real estate sectors. The consumer discretionary, communication services and information technology sectors outperformed the benchmark.

Portfolio Review

Stock selection in information technology, a sector overweight allocation to consumer discretionary and an underweight allocation to health care were the greatest overall contributors to the relative performance of the portfolio during the period. Top individual contributors included cloud software platform ServiceNow, Canadian ecommerce solution Shopify, Swedish audio streaming platform Spotify Technology SA, food delivery platform DoorDash and payments solution Block, Inc.

Stock selection in consumer discretionary and industrials and an underweight allocation to information technology were the greatest overall detractors from the relative performance of the portfolio. Top individual detractors included global mobility platform Uber Technologies, Latin American ecommerce platform MercadoLibre, Italian luxury brand Moncler SpA, Latin American virtual bank Nu Holdings Ltd. and Korean ecommerce platform Coupang.

Shares of ServiceNow outperformed after reporting revenue and earnings growth above expectations and raising subscription revenue guidance driven by new deals. ServiceNow has demonstrated strong platform adoption driven by horizontal expansion, uptake of its generative artificial intelligence (AI) solution Now Assist and complete AI vision as illustrated by the introductions of Agentic AI and Workflow Data Fabric. ServiceNow is the leading provider of enterprise software-as-a-service (SaaS)-based applications to define, structure, consolidate, manage and automate IT business processes. Grounded on simplicity and customizability, its technology centres on a suite of applications built on a proprietary platform that automates workflow, processes and integration-related business activities. Customers deploy its services to create a single system of record for IT, which reduces costs, streamlines operations, improves service delivery quality and enhances employee experience. As a preferred strategic technology partner for enterprises, the company's differentiation leadership has driven strong revenue growth, best-in-class gross retention and superior unit economics. We believe ServiceNow will likely benefit from major secular trends including digital transformation, workflow automation, customer and employee experience, low code/no code, and ESG (environmental, social and governance) imperative.

Shares of Shopify rallied after posting quarterly results and guidance for revenue growth above expectations. We believe that Shopify is unique due to its scale and network effects. Shopify is a one-stop, omni-channel commerce software provider for millions of brands and merchants that provides website, checkout, payment and shipping services. The company has a creative business model nurtured through partnerships with customers and application developers. Shopify integrates with social networking platforms and marketplaces, which enables scale that can help increase its take-rate as a percentage of gross merchandise volume and increase margins over time. The company's "Shop Pay" product increases speed at checkout and enables higher checkout conversion rates for merchants while "Shopify Plus" serves large enterprise customers including well-known global brands. In 2023, the Canadian retail software platform shifted its strategy by exiting its asset-heavy logistics services and reducing its workforce. Current investments in research and development to incorporate generative artificial intelligence features into its ecommerce software tools, such as "Shopify Magic" that automatically generates listings and images. We believe that Shopify can benefit from growth of both online and offline commerce given its product diversity and quality and low penetration of global retail sales.

Shares of Uber declined after Waymo announced the expansion of autonomous ride-hailing services to Miami, via its own ride-hailing app "Waymo One". We continue to closely monitor the potential benefit and impact of autonomous vehicle services to Uber's competitive positioning, given Waymo's hybrid approach of exclusive partnership with Uber in Atlanta and Austin while going direct

in California and Miami. Our investment thesis remains intact: Uber operates a global mobility platform in over 10,000 cities in over 70 countries through its mobility, delivery and freight services.² Uber's 161 million monthly active platform consumers average over five trips per month, and it has leadership position in its top mobility markets and in 7 out of its top 10 delivery countries.³ We believe that Uber is unique because of its strong network effects and scale, while gross bookings have penetrated less than 1% of a \$14 trillion total addressable market.² Uber's competitive advantage over other platforms that offer exclusively ride-booking or food delivery is a result of platform synergies, as evidenced by spending per cross-platform user that is over three times the average spend per users of a single vertical, with customer acquisition costs 50% lower² than paid marketing channels when it cross-sells delivery services to its mobility app users. As of September 30, 2024, the Uber One cross-platform membership program surpassed 25 million members and generated more than 40% of Uber's delivery gross bookings and a mid-teens percentage of mobility gross bookings.²

Shares of MercadoLibre declined after reporting lower-than-expected operating margins on increased investment in its credit card business and fulfilment centres to take advantage of strong growth in key markets including Brazil and Mexico. We believe that the company is making the right strategic decision to invest in the growth of its financial and ecommerce businesses to support long-term value creation. MercadoLibre is the largest ecommerce platform in Latin America, with a presence in 18 countries including Brazil, Argentina and Mexico; 61 million active buyers on its online marketplaces; and 56 million fintech active users of its Mercado Pago digital payments platform.⁴ We believe MercadoLibre can increasingly benefit by monetizing the uniqueness of its platform in Latin America, which has a population of more than 665 million and one of the fastest-growing internet penetration rates in the world.⁵

Strategy and Outlook

As a team, we continue to focus on bottom-up stock selection and the long-term outlook for companies owned in the portfolio. We assess company prospects over a five- to ten-year time horizon and own a portfolio of what we believe are undervalued, high quality companies with diverse business drivers not tied to any particular market environment.
