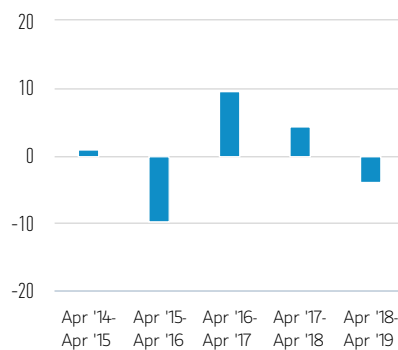
### Class CH (EUR) Shares (% net of fees) in EUR
